INSTITUTION PROFILE

The Government Arts College for Women was established in 1966 with the noble intention of providing higher education for Women of Thanjavur District. The College was renamed as 'Kunthavai Naacchyiaar Government Arts College for Women' in memory of the illustrious sister of Raja Raja Chola on the occasion of the 1000thanniversary celebration of the Coronation of the Great King of Thanjavur. The College which was originally affiliated to Madras University came under the jurisdiction of Bharathidasan University since 1982.
